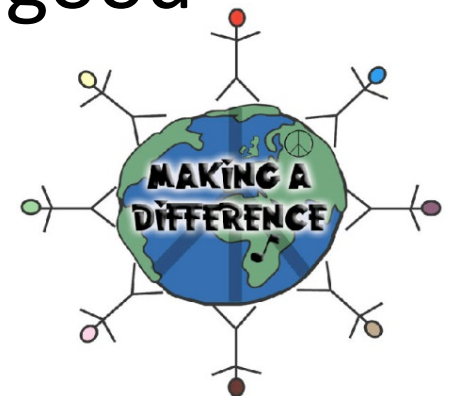

- ✓ I never share my password with anyone.

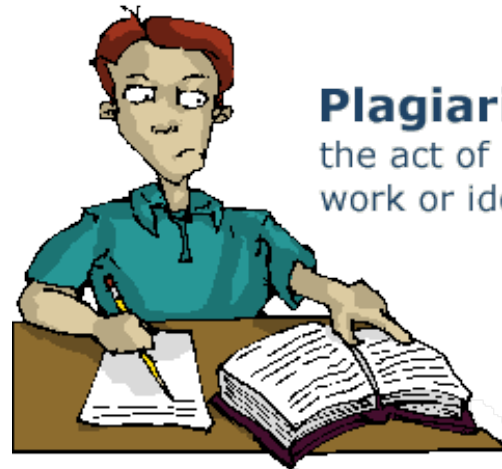


# Responsible Actions
